Abstracts are invited for poster presentations that explore issues related to misinformation or disinformation in the areas of crops, livestock, the environment, or human health. Selected posters will be showcased during the Africa Biennial Biosciences Communication Symposium 2025 (ABBC 2025) to be held from 26th – 28th August 2025.

ABBC 2025 Thematic Areas

- 1. Drivers of mis / disinformation on scientific innovations and their impact, with emphasis on communities, the youth and decision makers
- 2. Socio-economic impacts of underutilizing advanced innovative technologies in agriculture, health and for environmental protection and sustainability
- 3. Practical interventions to combat mis / disinformation in science.

The following order should be adhered to: Abstracts that do not follow this structure will not be considered for review.

- 1. Motivation, problem statement and aim
- 2. Strategies and tactics in handling the
- challenge
- 3. Results
- 4. Conclusion (lessons learnt)

Guidelines for abstract submission

- Maximum 350 words
- Language: English only
- Font: Times New Roman 12 point with standard formatting

- Important Information:
- A poster presentation fee of USD 1,000 is applicable upon acceptance of the abstract.
- This fee is separate from the symposium registration fee.
- Selected presenters will receive further instructions regarding payment and poster specifications.
